Coronavirus Update

From April, the infection control requirements are changing again:

- Children and adults who are unwell/have a high temperature remain advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people.
- The government have advised that children can return to settings when they no longer have a high temperature and are otherwise well enough to attend.
- Although free tests are no longer available, anyone who does receive a positive Covid-19 test will be advised to stay at home for at least 5 days.

As these requirements are broadly equivalent to our pre-Covid sickness and welfare policies, we are now effectively reverting to these systems for handling all illness, including suspected cases of Coronavirus.

Due to high infection rates in the community, all visitors are still required to wear face coverings to protect the staff team. Please put your mask on before entering the building and do not remove it until after you have left.
