### **Coronavirus**

We're hopeful that the worst is now past, despite regular new infections amongst children. The majority of staff have been fully vaccinated, so exclusions amongst staff should now be less of an issue. As all children are exempt from contact exclusions, operational restrictions should now be limited to a new system of outbreak management protocols. This means that rooms will only face closure if there are significant numbers of positive cases in that room or across the Centre as a whole. We will keep you informed of any positive cases via our website and Facebook page. We ask that visitors continue to wear a face mask at all times.

Children with symptoms of Coronavirus or other acute respiratory infections (ARI) must still remain away from the Centre. Please do not bring your child to nursery if they have a temperature over 37.8C **and** any new symptoms of respiratory illness. They can return 24hrs after their temperature comes down and any cough has gone or reduced a to gentle, irritable cough.

Any child with a new, persistent cough **or** a temperature of 38C or above must still obtain a full PCR test, returning to nursery after negative testing and also in accordance with the ARI requirements listed above.

As the Coronavirus restrictions continue to lift, we are looking to restart the 5pm-5:50pm evening wraparound session. Changing shifts patterns takes a little time and we first need to assess which sessions there is demand for.

We are aiming to restart this service from Monday September 13<sup>th</sup>. If you would like to change your session times from this date, please speak to the office to book wraparounds by Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. Due to the amount of time that has passed since the extra hour was last offered, previous booking patterns will not be reinstated automatically.

Please let us know as soon as possible if your child will not be attending a session and remember to call in if you're expecting to arrive more than 1 hour late for any booked session. We need firm numbers by this time to prepare



meals, etc – and will also need to contact you to confirm the reason for absence.

## **Parking**

We have been asked to remind parents and carers to not use the City Academy's large staff car park at pick-up or drop-off. They resume normal hours in September and can issue penalty notices for unauthorised use. On-site parking for ECCC is strictly restricted to the bays at the front of our building. Thank you.
